- Analyze the approaches to live surgery for aneurysms.

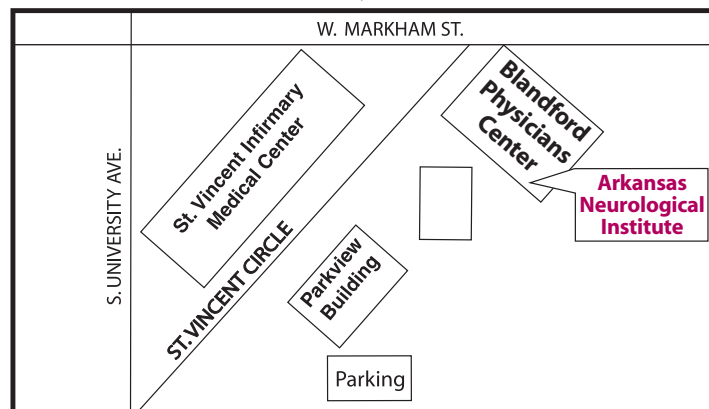
